

The regulations of the contest Street Art. Photo Call - hereafter referred to as “Regulations”.

I

General Provisions.

1. The Street Art Photo Call photo contest – (hereinafter referred to as the „Contest”) is organized by the Photography and Multimedia Forum association (KRS: 0000395724, NIP: 9662077880, REGON: 200629370) with its registered office in Bialystok on 6/34 Warszawska street – the main organizer of the International Festival of Photography - Bialystok INTERPHOTO 2017. The aim of the competition is to select the most interesting Street Photo projects and present them on display in the shop windows on the main street in Bialystok – Lipowa street.
2. These Regulations define the rules of organization and the procedure of the Contest.
3. Contest duration:

The Contest starts on 15.07.2017 and ends 01.09.2017. It will be concluded with an exhibition of works selected during this year’s edition of the INTERPHOTO Festival.

4. The selection board:

The Organizer will appoint the selection board (“Jury”) to assess the submitted photos and select the contest’s winners. The decisions taken by the Jury of the Contest will be final and incontestable.

5. Awards:

- The main award in the Contest is a presentation in the form of an exhibition during the 2017 INTERPHOTO Festival.
- The Jury can reward more than one image from the maximum of 5 photos submitted by the Participant.
- The Organizer will cover all cost related to printing and the presentation of photos, organization of the exhibition and the vernissage.

6. The Contest procedure:

- The Contest is open to anyone aged 18 or over. People under 18 must provide the parents’ or caregivers’ permission in writing to participate in the Contest.
- Competition Works will be accepted from 15/07/2017 to 01/09/2017.
- Each participant can submit a maximum of five photos.
- By submitting the photos, the Participant declares that he/she is the author of the project and has all the rights of disposal. Furthermore, the participant declares that the submitted photos do not breach the rights of any third parties, especially all the people presented in the photographs and that they have authorized the use of the photos in the Contest, including the distribution of their image. In the event of such consent being withheld, the Participant takes the responsibility for any justified claims of these parties.
- Applications should be sent to: street@interphoto.pl. Photographs should be sent in the following size: longer side 60 cm 120 dpi.
- The dead line for applications and competition works is 01/09/2017 11:59 p.m.
- The photographs can be taken using any technique.
- The topic of the Contest is street photography. The Organizer reserves the right to preliminarily assess the applications and reject them without providing any reasons.
- The author will grant the Organizer of the Competition a free, not limited by territory or time license to use the submitted photos for the purposes related to the organisation of the Contest, its marketing and the presentation of the results, including publication in the press, on websites and at the exhibition during Interphoto 2017.

The license will be issued for the following fields of use:

- I. within the scope of recording and copying the photographs- producing copies of the work by means of a particular technique, such as printing, reprography, magnetic recording and digital technology.
- II. Within the scope of distribution of the works in a manner other than specified in pt. I. above, - public display, presentation, projection, reproduction, broadcasting and re-broadcasting as well as making the work available to the public in such a manner that anyone could access the works in a chosen place and time. In particular, it authorizes the Organizer of the Contest to use the works free of charge by presenting them on the Internet, in the press publications related to this Contest, at post-competition exhibitions, posters and other advertising materials promoting the Contest, its future editions and all publishing related to the Contest.
 - The Organizer will inform the winners of the Contest results via e-mail.
 - Due to character of the exhibition (shop or workshop windows), the Organizer does not guarantee that all the works of the winners will be displayed.

II. Final provisions.

1. The Organizer reserves the right to verify whether the winners meet all the conditions laid down in the regulations of the Contest as well as in the law regulations. For this purpose, the organizer may require the participants to submit statements, provide specific data or present certain documents.
2. The personal data of the Participants will be processed in accordance with the conditions set out in the Act dated 29 August 1997 on the protection of personal data (unified text: Journal of Laws from 2002 No. 101, pos. 926, as amended) by the Organizer of the Contest, only in accordance with the rules specified in the Regulations. By giving their personal data, the Participant agrees on the data processing by the Organizer. The Organizer is the administrator of the Participants' personal data. Participants have the right to access their data and change it at any time.
3. By taking part in the Contest, the Participant explicitly accepts the provisions of these Regulations and confirm that he is in agreement with its contents.
4. The contest is not a promotion lottery in accordance with Article 2 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 9 of the Act of 29th July 1992 on games of chance and mutual betting, and is not subject to the rules contained in this act or implementation regulations related to this act.
5. The Contest is an international event.
6. These regulations have been prepared in two language versions: Polish and English
